SECTION 7: Handling and storage

7.1 Precautions for safe handling

: Avoid confinement. Do not allow to dry out. Explosive when dry. Vapors are heavier than air and may spread along floors. Vapors may form explosive mixtures with air. Prevent the creation of flammable or explosive concentrations of vapors in air and avoid vapor concentrations higher than the occupational exposure limits. Isolate from sources of heat, sparks and open flame. In addition, the product should only be used in areas from which all naked lights and other sources of ignition have been excluded.
