APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Application conditions

The surface to be treated must be dry, the temperature of the air at least +5 °C and the relative humidity of air below 80%.

Surface preparation

Remove loose and flaky putty from the grooves with a smoothing scraper. Clean the surface with sand paper or a wire brush.

Prime the putty grooves with Valtti-Pohjuste and a single application of diluted Lin Pellavaöljymaali or Teho Öljymaali before applying the putty. Spread Ikkunakitti with a putty knife. You can achieve a smooth surface by dipping the putty knife in water before smoothing the putty. Apply two coats of window frame paint (for exterior surfaces, e.g. Lin Pellavaöljymaali or Teho Öljymaali) to the putty surface in a few days. The paint must extend 1–2 mm over the window pane.

Cleaning of tools

Clean tools with White Spirit 1050.
