Customer: Tikkurila Oyi, Heidehofintie 2, FI-01301 Vantaa

The above product is used as an oil for worktops that can also be used for food contact. A sample provided by the customer was tested for its sensory behavior. An inhibitor test was carried out and metals in the acetic acid migrate were analyzed. Furthermore, polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH) and mineral oils were tested in the vegetable oil migrate. Siloxanes, medium to low volatile acrylates, highly volatile acrylates and N,N-diethylhydroxylamine were tested in the ethanol migrate. GC-MS screening was carried out in the diethylethermigrate. (WESSLING test report CAL24-056853-1 from 29.07.2024).

According to the type and scope of the investigations carried out, the sample tested complies with the regulations and standards listed below in their currently applicable versions in relation to the intended use described:

- Regulation (EC) No. 1935/2004
- German Food, Consumer Goods and Feed Code (LFGB)

Applicable limit values of the following regulations in their current version are being observed:

- Regulation (EU) No. 10/2011 (Plastics in contact with foodstuffs, used as a basis for assessment)
- BfR Recommendation No.XXXVI Papers, cardboards and paperboards for food contact
- EDQM Technical Guide on Metals and alloys used as food contact materials
